

- Note-5: The Provisional selection/allotment of seat in the counseling will be subject to verification of the original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of the concerned college. It shall be the sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility (as per Punjab Govt. Notification/Prospectus/MCC guidelines) of the allocated candidate before admitting the candidate to allotted course.
- **Note-6:** Candidate must have completed the age of 17 years at the time of admission or will complete that age on or before 31 December of the year of his/her admission. The candidates must be born on or before 31.12.2008.
- Note-7: The candidates who are not eligible for State Quota seats in MBBS Course as per Pb. Govt. Notification will be considered during subsequent Rounds of Counseling for BDS Course only after exhausting Punjab State candidates.

In CWP No. 29483 of 2022 & CWP No. 29374 of 2022 titled Himanshu Verma & ors. Vs SOP & Ors. respectively has resolved to create one supernumerary seat for Smt. Vasu Sirohi (Petitioner) at Dr. B.R.Ambedkar State Institute of Medical Sciences, (AIMS) Sahibjada, Ajit Singh Nagar which will be further adjusted for the annual intake for the academic year 2025-26. Thus the annual intake of MBBS students for academic year 2024-25 was increased by one seat i.e. from 100 to 101 at DBRSIMS (AIMS), Mohali and annual intake of MBBS students for academic year 2025-26 shall be decreased by one seat i.e. from 100 to 99.

Accordingly, one seat at Dr. B.R.Ambedkar State Institute of Medical Sciences, (AIMS) Sahibjada, Ajit Singh Nagar is decreased from the intake of session 2025-26 i.e. from 100 to 99.

### **INTRODUCTION**

### **BRIEF HISTORY:**

The University was established at Faridkot under an Act of Punjab State Legislature (Punjab Act No. 18 of 1998) in the name of great Sufi Saint Sheikh Farid Ganj-E-Shakar, (1173 1265 A.D.) in 1998 for purposes of affiliating, teaching and ensuring proper and systematic instruction, training and research in Modern Systems of Medicine and Indian Systems of Medicine. It is not only affiliating and examining body but also a teaching and research centre in health sciences. It is expected to play a vital role in improving the standards of medical and health education in the state and in conducting relevant research in all aspects of health sciences, basic as well as applied, which ultimately will ameliorate the health standards of the people of Punjab. II is believed that the university will be a trend setter in developing appropriate modes and models of health care to ensure quality health care to the people. The University has been recognized by MCI vide letter no. V/11015/3/2000-ME (UG) dated 9th June, 2000. The UGC has also included the University in the list of recognized universities maintained by the University Grants Commission, under section 2(1) of the UGC Act. 1956 vide letter no. F.9-3/97 (CPP-I) dated 4 July. 2002. The Regional Director. World Health Organization, Regional Office for South-East Asia, World Health House, New Delhi has also forwarded the name of the University for inclusion in the World Directory of Medical Schools vide letter No. M12/6212 dated 6 May 2002. The University is also included in the list of Commonwealth Universities and their yearbook 2001 at page No. 692 (Vol. I). Established with a mission to create an intellectual, academic and physical environment conducive to free flow of ideas and exchange of information between various faculties of the university, between this university and other universities of health sciences in the country and abroad, thereby opening a window to the world for the health professionals, health planners, health managers, biomedical and social scientists and educationalists in health sciences of the country. Efforts are on to establish contact with various institutions towards achieving this goal. UNIVERSITY'S PRESENT STATUS: New buildings of the University and its constituent college, GGS Medical College & Hospital were completed in the year 2011. The university was shifted to its new building situated at Sadiq Road, Faridkot in July 2011. Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab inaugurated two new University buildings (Senate Block and Academic Block) on 22-09-2011. Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister inaugurated the Radiotherapy Unit, and other buildings of GGS Medical College & Hospital, on 23-09-2011. The GGS Medical College & Hospital, a constituent college of the University is also shifted to its new building. The University Campus comprises of GGS Medical College along with Auditorium of 800 capacity, Senate Block, Academic Block, University College of Nursing, University College of Physiotherapy, University Institute of Para-Medical Sciences, University Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Dept. of Nuclear Medicine, Telemedicine, Edusat and a well equipped stateof-the-art 1200 bedded hospital, Drug De-addiction & Treatment Centre at Faridkot. The State

Institute of Nursing and Para-Medical Sciences, Village – Badal (Muktsar), Institute of Nursing (University Regional Centre) at Shri Goindwal Sahib and Advanced Cancer Diagnostic Treatment & Research Centre and Drug De-Addiction & Treatment Centre at Bathinda are also run by University. Coveted projects to set up Trauma Centre, Regional Cancer Centre are in process. The University has added to its academic convoy University Library & Informatics Division, Department of Health Sciences Library & Information System, University Centre of Excellence in Research, Rose Garden and Herbal Garden. The university has started number of employment-oriented diploma courses and certificate programs in health sciences and allied services.

### **COLLEGES AFFILIATED WITH UNIVERSITY:**

At present the University is having 164 affiliated colleges (09 Medical, 14 Dental, 124 Nursing, 08 Physiotherapy, 1 Pharmacy, 1 Sports Medicine and 7 allied and health care) comprising 153 affiliated and 11 constituent Colleges. University will soon endeavor to achieve excellence in health care delivery and medical education and research in the State. Admissions to various undergraduate and post graduate courses in the affiliated institutions of this University in the State of Punjab are made on merit basis through the conduct of Entrance Tests. The PPMET-2025 is being accordingly conducted to enroll suitable candidates in the Nursing Colleges of the State for the session 2025. The university is now primarily focusing on strengthening postgraduate medical education and research and evolving as a centre of excellence in a rural backdrop. Selection of the candidates to any institution shall be made on merit and in transparent manner as per Punjab Government Notification/s..

### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS (PLEASE READ IN DETAIL)**

- 1. This prospectus is divided into 3 parts:
  - Part-A Pertains to the general procedure for applying to admission, submission of admission application/counseling form, deposition of fee, important instructions, joining, etc and demonstration of steps for applying online application form and filling online choices/preference of course/college/quota during online counseling.
  - Part-B Pertains to Punjab Govt. Notifications/corrigendum issued from time to time for admission to MBBS/BDS Courses.
  - Part-C Annexures/specimens of various categories, self-declarations and other Notifications issued by Govt. of India/ Govt. of Punjab
- 2. Candidates must strictly follow the instructions laid out in the Prospectus and University website. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be disqualified.
- 3. This prospectus is subject to alteration(s) / modification(s) at any time without notice. Please visit University website from time to time. Admissions including Eligibility to MBBS/BDS Courses shall be governed and regulated as per the rules and regulations etc., as per Punjab Govt. notifications.
- 4. Instructions in this prospectus are liable to change based on decision(s) taken by the Punjab Government/University/Govt. of India/MCC from time to time. There is no equity or any rights that are/or deemed to be arising in favour of candidate.
- 5. The candidate should read the eligibility condition carefully. Mere submission of application for admission/counseling does not entitle him/her for admission. Eligibility conditions for admissions are given in the Notification. The eligibility shall be determined by the Admission Committee/Principal of concerned college at the time of counseling/admission. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Govt. notification will not be considered for admission. Eligibility is also subject to medical fitness and such criteria as may be prescribed by the Punjab Government/ University/Medical institutions/ National Medical Commission/Dental Council of India.
- 6. Candidate's eligibility is purely provisional & subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria as per Punjab Government Notification incorporated in this prospectus.
- 7. Applications of candidates producing false or fabricated information shall not be considered and candidates shall be further debarred from participating in any future counseling to be conducted by BFUHS, Faridkot.
- 8. Any attempt by a candidate to influence directly or indirectly any person concerned with the admission process will lead to disqualification of the candidate.
- 9. Distribution of seats will be as per Punjab Govt. Notification, the list of eligible colleges/seats may increase/decrease, subject to the orders of Hon'ble Courts/NMC/DCI/Govt. The final position of seats will be displayed at the time of counselling.
- 10. Seat matrix process shall be available on the university website at the time of filling options/preferences of College/Quota/Category for online counseling.
- 11. The admission for MBBS/BDS courses shall be made only to those institutions which have permission from all of the concerned authorities.
- 12. Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Medical/Dental Colleges. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the provisionally allocated candidates before their joining/admission.
- 13. The fee structure for the Government/Privately managed colleges is as per Punjab Government notification(s) for MBBS/BDS courses. If Punjab Government issues any subsequent amendment/corrigendum for change in fee structure, the same will be applicable in letter and spirit.
- 14. In case of any discrepancy or contradiction between the Government notification/s and the University instructions contained in this Prospectus, the letter and spirit of the notification(s) shall be prevailing, however in academic matters the University shall be the final Authority.

- 15. Deposition of fee does not confirm the admission of the candidate, whether it is challenged in the Hon'ble Court.
- 16. Changes, if any, in the Schedule / Counseling etc. shall be notified only through website of the University i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in
- 17. The allotment of College to the applicants for admission, shall be made as per merit determined on the basis of NEET-UG-2025 and the choice of the station opted by the candidate at the time of online counseling.
- 18. Ragging is prohibited in all forms. This is for the information of all candidates that as per Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if explanation is not found satisfactory, action will be taken as per rules.
- 19. **HSLIBNET FEE:**-University has started Health Sciences Library Network (HSLIBNET) to provide access to eresources to the students of all colleges affiliated with the University for which one time fee as mentioned below or as amended from time to time will be charged from all students who got admission in MBBS/BDS courses. HSLIBNET fee will be collected alongwith tuition fee at the time of admission: -:-

### 20. Post Matric Scholarship Scheme:

SC category candidates are entitled for scholarship from the Department of Welfare, Govt. of Punjab if they fulfill their terms and conditions. SC category candidates, whose family annual income from all sources is less than Rs.2,50,000/-(Rupees Two Lakh fifty thousand only) during the last Financial Year, are entitled for post matric scholarship as per guidelines of Govt. of India and Punjab Govt. The candidates will have to submit Freeship Card alongwith admission For details regarding this scheme/forms/procedure, colleges/candidates should visit the website of Punjab Govt., Deptt. of Medical Education and Research (www.punjabmedicaleducation.org) and University website (www.bfuhs.ac.in). For any query/clarification, candidates/respective colleges can contact the office of Director, Medical Education and Research, Punjab, Chandigarh or Director, Welfare Deptt., Punjab, Chandigarh. ### 21. **Application Fee**

- (b) Admission Application Fee will not be accepted in any form after due date/time in any case.
- (c) Only those Admission Application Forms will be considered for counselling, fee for which has been deposited by due date/time.
- (d) No request for accepting the Admission Application Forms after due date/time will be entertained.
- (e) Mere deposition of fee will not entitle the candidate for claim of admission.
- (f) Fee once deposited in University Account will not be refunded/adjusted in any case.
- 22. Notwithstanding the participation of candidates in counselling, only eligible candidates, as per Government notification(s), shall be considered for admission.

- 23. Candidates applying under any of the reserve category are directed to fill the right category code mentioned in this prospectus for claiming reservation under a category and also upload/bring/attach all relevant documents/proof of respective category with online admission application form and photocopies and original documents at the time of counseling/admission.
- 24. <u>Instructions for NRI Candidates only</u>:- Candidates who wants to apply under NRI quota seats, have to obtain provisional Eligibility/equivalency certificate from BFUHS, Faridkot and will have to qualify NEET-UG-2025 and candidates will apply on prescribed proforma available on university website along with prescribed fee for seats under NRI Quota.



### **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

- 1. The **admission to MBBS/BDS Courses** shall be open to candidates who have qualified NEET-UG-2025 and eligible as per Punjab Govt. notifications and subsequent amendment(s)/corrigendum(s).
- Merely applying for admission to MBBS/BDS courses on the basis of NEET-UG-2025 will not entitle the Candidates eligibility. A Merit of a candidate for admission will be determined by the Admission Committee strictly as per rules and regulations laid down in the Punjab Govt. Notification(s) as published in this prospectus and all other such documents as are required with the ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM.
- 3. Counseling/Admissions shall be conducted by the **Admission Committee** constituted by the Punjab Government for this purpose.
- 4. **Age:** As specified in NEET-UG 2025 information bulletin.

### **PROCEDURE OF ONLINE COUNSELLING**



### Step-I SUBMISSION OF ONLINE ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM

- 1. Candidates should read the Punjab Govt. notification and instructions as contained in the Prospectus carefully on University website i.e. <a href="https://www.bfuhs.ac.in">www.bfuhs.ac.in</a>.
- 2. Only NEET-UG-2025 qualified candidates are eligible to apply for admission to MBBS/BDS Courses.
- 3. Candidates are required to register themselves for admission to MBBS/BDS Courses through online portal by due date and time.
- 4. Candidates are advised to fill the online admission application form well in advance to avoid the network congestion in the last days. BFUHS will not be responsible for network congestion/problems. No request for accepting the forms after cut-off date will be entertained.
- 5. Following documents are required to be uploaded for the online registration:
  - i. Soft copy of Photograph of the candidate (Maximum size 30 KB).
  - ii. Soft copy of the signatures of the candidate (Maximum Size 30 KB).

### Specifications for Photograph:-

- I. A colour photograph of minimum 35x45 mm with at least 75% coverage of face & head of the candidate.
- II. A caption indicating name of candidate and date of taking photograph should be there at the bottom of photo.
- I. Photograph should be taken in a white /very light colored background.
- II. Photograph should not have cap or goggles. Spectacles are allowed if being used regularly. POLAROID and COMPUTER generated photos are not acceptable.
- V. The photograph needs to display full front view of the face. Please look directly into the camera with a neutral expression.
- VI. Please avoid photograph with reflection or shadow on the face.
- VII. The photograph needs to be printed on a high quality paper with at least 600 dpi resolutions.
- VIII. The colours must possess the natural appearance and skin tone.
- IX. The photograph must not have kinks, scratches and stains.

**Note:** Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected.

- 6. Candidate will have to submit the correct account details as required at the time of submission of online application form and will upload the cancelled cheque of same account in support of verification of account number for fee refund (as applicable).
- 7. After completion of filling online admission application form, University will issue a unique Registration ID (i.e. Login ID) and password to the candidate at his/her registered Mobile number through SMS/ email
- 8. Merely submission of online application form & fee does not confer any right to the candidate secure a seat for MBBS/BDS course.
- 9. No request for submitting online Admission Application Form after due date/time will be entertained on any ground.
- 10. Candidate shall submit online ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM only once. Applications submitted more than once are liable to be rejected.
- 11. Candidates are required to fill online Admission Application Form very carefully and should not leave any column blank.
- 12. After filling of successful online Admission Application Form, candidate has to deposit the fee through online payment gateway of University.
- 13. Admission Application forms applied without fee will not be accepted.
- 14. After the last date for applying online application form, it will get locked automatically. Thereafter no change(regarding any particulars) can be made and no request/application will be considered/accepted, in this regard.
- **Step-II** Deposition of Fee:- Candidates will have to deposit the fee through online payment gateway of University.

- (a) Registration for admission to MBBS/BDS courses is to be undertaken online at the University website www.bfuhs.ac.in.
- (b) Application form for admission to MBBS/BDS courses submitted offline/printed copy shall not be accepted.
- (c) Incomplete application forms shall not be considered and are liable to be rejected. **The fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances.**
- (d) The allotment of College to the applicants for admission, shall be made as per merit determined on the basis of NEET-UG-2025 and the choice of the station opted by the candidate at the time of online counseling.
- 13. Candidates must strictly follow the instructions printed in the Prospectus and University website. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be disqualified.

# 14. Fill category carefully in the online Admission Application Form. Category once claimed will not be changed in any case after submitting the form.

Those candidates, who do not fill/claim any category code as per prospectus or fill a wrong category code other than mentioned in prospectus, will be treated in Open merit. The candidate may select a category code from the codes given below and fill the category accordingly. More than one category may be filled by a candidate if it is considered applicable in the candidate's particular case. Category codes are exclusively for the purpose of facilitating the candidates to know and understand his/her respective merit placement at the time of counseling in various reserved categories as have been filled by him/her. Reserve category selection on the part of the candidate shall not in any case be construed to give him/her any legitimacy or right or claim on the benefits for reserved seats during admission. Claims to admissions against reserved seats in MBBS/BDS courses will be on the basis of appropriate claims made in the Admission Application Form subject to rules and regulations contained in the Punjab Government Notifications printed in the Part-B of this prospectus and as per the decisions of the Selection Committee constituted for this purpose by the Punjab Government.

- Note:- No benefit of reservation whatsoever shall be given if the claim is not made in Admission Application Form. Change in category or any other particular is allowed before the last date for submission of application form and thereafter no change will be allowed under any circumstances.
- 15. After successful registration of the applicant, a unique Registration ID (i.e. Login ID) and password will be allotted to the candidate at his/her registered mobile no. or email through SMS or by email. Registration ID and password shall be required from time to time throughout the process of admission, the candidates are therefore advised not to disclose it to any unknown person and to keep it confidential.

### Step-III Document Verification after applying Admission Application Form

As per schedule at page no. 3, the document verification of Minority Quota candidates will be conducted in the concerned Institutes. The certificate of Micro Reserved and SC/BC Category candidates will be verified at the time of reporting in the Provisionally allotted college. The candidate applying under SC/BC Category shall produce the reserve category certificate to be issued by the Competent Authority of Punjab only which will be verified at the time of reporting in the Provisionally allotted college.

### **Step-IV The Provisional Merit List**

The University shall display the State Merit (of registered candidates) on the University website as per schedule. After displaying the state merit list of registered candidates, the University shall open the online portal. Online counselling will be held through website where online counselling form will be available as per schedule specified in prospectus/fromtime to

time University website.

### Step-V Filling of choices/preferences of course during online counselling

- Only registered candidates are eligible for the counselling(s), no candidate shall be allowed to participate in the counselling (online/physical) without registration and deposition of fee before last date as prescribed.
- 2. The candidates should read the eligibility conditions carefully and just exercising online option of college / appearing in counselling does not entitle him/her for admission. Eligibility conditions for admissions are as per Punjab Govt. Notification(s). The eligibility shall be determined by the Principal at the time of counseling at the allotted College. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Govt. notification will not be considered for admission.
- 3. Counselling for admission to MBBS/BDS, session 2025 will be conducted online followed by Physical reporting of the candidates to allotted colleges. During online counseling, candidates will fill online counselling form. They shall give their preferences of course, college, category, quota. Candidates are advised to take proper caution while filling up the order of preferences of course, college, category, quota. Candidates of reserved categories (who scored marks equivalent or more than the minimum cut-off of open merit NEET marks) are eligible in open merit and will be considered in open merit first as the Provisional Seat will be allocated as per NEET merit and in order of online preferences submitted by the candidate.

### Step-VI Important Instructions

#### Provisional allotment of seat:-

- 1. The seat will be allotted provisionally to the candidate as per merit list and institutional preferences submitted by him/her in online counseling form. Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Colleges. After provisional allocation of seat, candidate shall deposit the tuition fee through online payment gateway and report to the allocated college for verification of documents and checking of eligibility. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the provisionally allocated candidate before their joining/admission.
- 2. After provisional allocation of seat, candidates can download provisional allocation letter from the University website after logging into their account and will report to the respective college along with all original documents for the checking of documents and their eligibility. If found eligible, he/she has to deposit the tuition fee through online payment gateway mere deposition of tuition fee only. Issuing of Provisional Selection Slip alone does not confer any right to claim the allocation of seat in respective college as their provisional selection is subject to verification of documents and checking of eligibility as per guidelines of Punjab Govt. Notification published in the Prospectus.
- 3. If any candidate does not follow the said process, his/her allocated seat will be cancelled automatically without any intimation and his/her seat shall be declared as vacant for the subsequent round of counseling.
- 4. In case candidate's seat is upgraded/changed in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of counselling and he/she has already deposited the tuition fee during 1<sup>st</sup> Round of online counseling, then, he/she is not required to deposit fee again, only difference in fee, if any, shall need to be deposited.
- 5. If any candidate is not willing to change/upgrade the seat/college in 2<sup>nd</sup> round of counseling, he/she is not required to participate in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of counselling. In case, candidate wishes/intends to upgrade/change his/her seat he/she will have to participate in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of counselling by depositing requisite amount of willingness fee equivalent to the amount of security(refundable/forfeitable) and give his/her preferences afresh for the course/college/category/quota.

- 6. In case any candidate wants to quit the course/seat, he/she will have to submit application to the respective college regarding his/her surrender of seat with free exit/forfeiture of fee within stipulated period (date and time) as per notice published on the University website. In case of surrender with forfeiture, the penalty will be imposed as per Gazette Notification No. MCI-34(41)/2018-Med./109835 dated 18/05/2018 (available at page no. 69 to 71).
- 7. It is pertinent to mention here that the candidates can fill the choices of colleges/quota which are not reflecting in the vacancy position of seats as few seats may arise due to shifting of candidates from one college/quota/category to another college during subsequent round of counseling as per instructions of MCC, Govt. of India. In this regard, it is made clear that during subsequent round of online counseling one can upgrade/shift seat as per his/her choice by vacating the already occupied seat of 1st counseling. This is also made clear that some seats of reserve category, NRI Quota seats etc may remain vacant after exhausting all candidates of respective quota/category as per notification. Therefore, as per MCC guidelines, any seat remained vacant due to shifting/conversion of seats, it is not mandatory to fill only those choices/preferences which are reflected in the vacancy position of seats. So candidates are advised to fill the maximum preferences/choices of colleges as per their choice. The seats in subsequent round will be allocated as per availability of seats as per merit cum choice/preference submitted afresh by the candidate.
- 8. The candidate to whom seat will be allotted in 2<sup>nd</sup> Round and he/she will not submit joining in the respective college upto stipulated period, then the security amount deposited by him/her will be forfeited as per Gazette Notification dated 18.05.2018.

### Step-VII Verification of Documents after provisional allotment of seat:-

- 1. The Provisional selected candidates desired to join the provisionally allotted seat, shall have to report to the Principal of concerned college and required to produce all of their original documents/credentials for verification. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the provisionally allocated candidate before their joining/admission. If the selected candidate is found eligible as per instructions of Punjab Govt. Notification then he/she will be allowed to submit his/her joining report after medical checkup.
- 2. After the verification of the documents and checking of eligibility, the candidate can pay the online fee after generating allotment letter both at his/her own level or college level.



- The Government of Punjab is pleased to notify the admission criteria

  2024 onwards in the Government & Private Medical/Dental Institutes,
  including Institutes under Private Universities and Minority Institutions
  in the State of Punjab.
- All admissions of Govt. Quota seats/Management Quota Seats, including NRI and any Minority Quota seats, and any other Seats, whatsoever, in the Government & Private Medical/Dental Institutes, including Institutes under Private Universities and Minority Institutions shall be based on the merit of National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET).
- The Government of Punjab is pleased to authorize Baba Farid
  University of Health Sciences, Faridkot (BFUHS) to conduct
  centralized counselling for admissions, for seats as spelled out at Sr.
  No. 2, on the basis of marks obtained in NEET.
- 4. Eligibility criteria for admission in Government & Private Medical/Dental Institutes, including Institutes under Private Universities and Minority Institutions for MBBS and BDS seats, as spelled out at Sr. No. 2 shall be in accordance with eligibility criteria/ qualifications/qualifying criteria as prescribed in the Information Bulletin for National Eligibility-cum- Entrance Test (NEET) issued by NTA (National Testing Agency) for the corresponding year.
- 5. After the declaration of the NEET result, the candidates shall apply on the specific proforma for all seats, except All India quota seats, to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, (BFUHS), Faridkot. Admission shall be made by the Admission Committee through a Centralized Counselling by BFUHS, Faridkot on the basis of inter-se merit of NEET.
- 6. Admissions to Private institutions/Universities shall also be governed by the provisions of Para 2 above and also as per the provisions of the "Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee & Making of Reservations) Act, 2006."and its Amendment Act 2020.

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- A candidate from reserved Category shall have the right to compete
  for admission in General/Unreserved category seats as per his/her
  merit on the day of counselling and candidate so selected shall not be
  counted towards admission in the reserve category.
- 8. The schedule of counselling, admission and start of classes shall be in conformity with the schedule laid down by National Medical Commission/Dental Council of India/ Hon'ble Supreme Court of India / State Government. Fee and other charges for submission of the application and counselling shall be notified by BFUHS as per Government approval.
- 9. Out of the total seats in Government Institutes, 15% seats (All India Quota) in MBBS/BDS courses shall be filled by the Government of India through centralized Counselling by Medical Counselling Committee of DGHS, MOHFW, Govt. of India on the basis of marks obtained in NEET. Rest 85% seats shall be filled as per merit of NEET by the Admission Committee constituted by the Government of Punjab.
- The details of the institutions and category wise seats shall be available on the official website of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in.

### 11. The eligibility of the candidate for state quota is as under:

- a) The candidate should be Citizen of India.
- b) The candidate must have passed 10+1 & 10+2 from the state of Punjab or
- c) The candidate should have born in the state of Punjab or
- d) The candidate must be a "Permanent Resident" in the state of Punjab

### Note: "Permanent resident" in the State of Punjab means: -

Candidates who have studied for a period of 5 years in Punjab or have studied in Punjab for 2 years just preceding the qualifying examination for the admission. or

### ii) Children wards of

- a) The employees of Punjab Govt. posted in or outside Punjab State or working on deputation having atleast 3 years of service.or
  - b) The employee of Govt. of India posted inChandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years. or
- c) The employees of State Govt. institutions/undertakings who are posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years. or
- d) The employees having atleast 3 years of service in autonomous

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- bodies/companies in which Punjab Govt. has 20% or more shares. or
- e) The Residents who are residing outside Punjab on Account of their service either with the GOI or with the employees of the Govt. of Punjab in the matter of issue of 'Residence Certificate' provided the permanent address of such employees fall in the reorganized Punjab i.e. on or after 01.11.66, as per their service books. or
  - f) \*The employees borne on the establishment of Punjab and the Haryana High Court discharging duties in connection with the affairs of the State of Punjab having atleast three years of service who have not availed this facility from their parent State and State of Haryana and U.T; Chandigarh. or
- iii) Children/wards of the pensioners of Punjab Government irrespective of the fact that the original home of the retiree is in a state other than Punjab or he has settled after retirement in or outside Punjab.or
- iv) Children/wards of persons who have settled in Punjab or had resided in Punjab for a period of atleast 5 years at any time prior to the date of submission of the application either in pursuit of a profession or holding of a job.

In addition the following categories of candidates are also eligible for admission in MBBS and BDS courses in medical and dental institutes in Punjab:-

a) Wards of defence personnel posted in Punjab.

- b) Candidates seeking admissions under NRI category.
- c) Candidates belonging to minority community who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions.
- d) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central Government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/ Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out of the three years preceding year of passing 10+2 examination but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to which their children/wards/dependents have passed class XI and/or XII or equivalent qualifying examinations from outside Punjab. However those who remained posted in Punjab continuously for these three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.

Provided however, that in case adequate number of candidates is not available for BDS course, then candidates who are not eligible for

- (ii) The eligibility of the candidates shall be determined by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, who shall issue an eligibility certificate to each such candidate.
- (iii) The fee notified for NRI category shall be applicable to NRI candidates getting admission to Govt. Medical/Dental Colleges also.
- (iv) The NRI students shall have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installments as provided.
- (v) The Centralized Counselling of NRI quota seats shall be held before the Counselling for other categories. In case of any seat remaining vacant under NRI quota, during / after 2nd Centralized Counselling of NRI quota in State Colleges, it shall go to General category and in the Private Colleges/Minority colleges shall go to General Category of the

### 18. Declaration to be submitted by the candidate

### 19. Candidates already admitted:-

Any candidate, who has taken admission in the previous session in MBBS/BDS course, shall be eligible to seek admission again in the same course, like a fresh applicant based on marks of NEET in the year of consideration on the basis of NOC issued by the Chairman Selection committee. If candidate leaves within two years he will have to submit full course fee

#### 20. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- a) The University shall display a combined merit list of all candidates including reserve category and also a separate merit list of different categories which should be displayed on the University website at least 7 days before the counseling.
- b) The admission shall be made to only those institutes which are approved from all the concerned authorities on or before the first counselling. Institute(s) which has applied for affiliation and/or for approval of competent authority(ies) but are unable to get affiliation and such approval from all the concerned authorities before this day shall not be considered for counselling.
- c) In order to ensure completion of the prescribed courses(s) and period of study as well as commencement of examination(s) in time, no admission(s) adjustment(s) shall be made after date as notified by the Medical Council of India, New Delhi/NMC of the corresponding year regardless of any vacancy(ies) that might exist or might arise thereafter for any reason.
- d) The seats of All India quota remaining unfilled, if surrendered by the Director General of Health Services (Medical Counselling Committee, New Delhi), to the Punjab Government, shall be filled as per NEET merit and existing reservation rules.
- e) In case of candidates whose parents are not alive, the dependency certificate shall have to be taken from the Deputy Commissioner / District Collector of the District or any other Government official duly

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- authorized by the State Government or Deputy Commissioner / District Collector where the candidate resides.
- f) The reservation for SC shall be calculated on total seats of an institution after deduction of All India Quota seats.
- g) Students claiming benefits of reservation under SC/BC category shall be required to produce a certificate from the competent authority as per latest instructions of Govt. of Punjab. Further, a valid Backward Class Certificate must be produced as per the latest instructions of Department of Welfare, Government of Punjab in which the annual income of the family is clearly mentioned.
- h) Scheduled Caste/ Backward Classes category candidates shall be eligible to apply for Post- Matric Scholarship and reimbursement of fee if they fulfill the terms and conditions laid down by Department of Welfare, Govt. of Punjab.
- i) The Reservation of Physically Challenged persons shall be as per the provision of Right of Persons with Disability Act 2016.

New Delhi, the 18th May, 2018

No.MCI-34(41)/2018-Med./109835.— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 33 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956), the Medical Council of India with the previous sanction of the Central Government,

hereby makes the following Regulations to further amend the "Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997", namely: -

- (i) These Regulations may be called the "Regulations on Graduate Medical Education (Amendment), 2018.
  - (ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. In the "Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997", following clause shall be added after 5A(3):-
  - 5A(4) In order to prevent seat blocking in common counseling for admission to MBBS course and permissibility to exercise fresh choice during counseling, forfeiture of fee shall be in accordance with the Matrix contained in "Appendix F".
- 3. In the "Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997", in Appendix 'F' the following "Note" shall be added below the Time Schedule for completion of the admission process for first MBBS course for the academic year 2018-19 and onwards: -

#### Note:

- All India Quota Seats (15%) remaining vacant after last date for joining, i.e. 22<sup>nd</sup> July of the present Admission year will be deemed to be converted into State quota.
- Institute/college/courses permitted after 31st May will not be considered for admission/ allotment of seats for current academic year.
- 3. In any circumstances, last date for admission/joining will not be extended after 31st August.
- 4. For the purpose of ensuring faithful obedience to the above time-schedule, Saturday, Sunday or Holidays (except National Holiday on account of Independence Day, 15th August) shall be treated as working days.
- 5. The following Matrix shall be applicable with regard to permissibility to students to exercise fresh choice during counseling:-

#### NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 18th November, 2021

No. UGMEB/NMC/Rules & Regulations/2021/.— In exercise of the powers conferred by section 57 read with sub-section (1) of section 24 of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 (30 of 2019), the National Medical Commission hereby makes the following regulations namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These regulations may be called the National Medical Commission (Compulsory Rotating Medical Internship) Regulations, 2021.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette of India,
  - Definitions. (1) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,—
  - "Act" means the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 (30 of 2019);
  - (b) "Commission" means the National Medical Commission constituted under section 3 of the Act;
  - (c) "Curriculum" includes the elements detailed in Schedule III;
- (d) "Foreign Medical Graduate" shall have the meaning assigned to it in clause (c) of regulation 2 of the National Medical Commission (Foreign Medical Graduate Licentiate) Regulations, 2021;
- (e) "Intern" means a medical graduate undergoing compulsory rotating internship training under these regulations;
- (f) "Log Book" means an official document chronicling the performance of an intern and a record of the work done, procedures performed and competencies achieved by him:
- (g) "Mentor" shall mean an appropriately qualified and trained medical teacher and senior to the trainee, who guides the trainee in all aspects of graduation, such as, education, skill enhancement, research work and ethical values;
- (h) "Notification" means a notification published in the Official Gazette and the expression "notify" shall be construed accordingly;
- (i) "Permanent Registration" is the registration of eligible persons with a duly recognised primary medical qualification as regulated under the provisions of Chapter VI of the Act, that provides license to an individual to independently practice modern scientific system of medicine or allopathy in India;
- () "Primary Medical Qualification" means a medical graduation degree, such as, Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) conferred in India or an equivalent qualification of any country other than India or an

erstwhile licentiate qualification of India granted under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956), which are in force as on the date of commencement of the Act that continues to be in force till the date of their expiry for all purposes, as if they had been issued or granted under the provisions of the Act or the rules or regulations made

- (k) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these regulations;
- "University" shall have the same meaning assigned to it in clause (1) of section 2 of the University 0 Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956) and includes a health University in India or an equivalent institution outside India that has a Medical faculty duly recognised in that country.
- (2) Words and expressions used in these regulations and not defined herein but defined in the Act shall have the respective meanings assigned to them in the Act.
- Internship to be an integral part of undergraduate medical education. Without prejudice to the provisions of these regulations, compulsory rotating medical internship shall be an integral part of undergraduate
- Bar on licence to permanent registration.—No medical graduate shall be eligible to permanent registration to practice medicine in India unless he undergoes the compulsory rotating medical internship in India as provided in Schedule II.
- Duration and Period of Internship The overall duration of compulsory rotating medical internship shall not be less than twelve months and institutions or hospitals from where it may be undergone shall be such as specified in Schedule I and shall be completed within a period of two years from the date of qualifying credentials to pursue compulsory rotating medical internship.
- Quality of internship.— No medical graduate shall be considered to have undergone compulsory rotating medical internship unless
  - all the essential (practical) aspects of medicine in the areas specified in the Schedule III and IV are completed during the internship; and
  - the entire course of internship is done under active supervision of the mentor duly qualified in that respect, and the mentor has duly issued certificate in that respect, as per the proforma provided in Schedule IV
- Qualifications of mentor. No person shall be eligible either to supervise a medical internee or certify the completion of compulsory rotating medical internship, unless he possesses all the qualifications specified in
- The Dean/ Principal/ Director or any other equivalent authority shall be responsible for implementation of these Regulations.

#### DURATION and PERIOD OF CRMI

#### **Total Duration**

Every candidate shall be required to undergo a compulsory rotating medical internship (CRMI) for a minimum period of twelve months, to the satisfaction of the college authorities and the University concerned after passing the final Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) examination/ National Exit Exam for MBBS (Next), so as to be eligible for the award of the MBBS degree by the respective Universities.

#### Period for Completion

- The Internship shall be completed within two years of passing the final MBBS or Foreign Medical (a) Graduate Examination (FMGE) or NExT Step-1 examination, whenever in force.
- The minimum duration of compulsory rotating medical internship may be extended appropriately by a reasonable period on recommendation by the College or University for reasons including but not limited to:
  - insufficient period of attendance; or
- (ii) any exigency such as disasters or unforeseen circumstances in the country as notified by the Government of India or any competent authority duly authorized to do so.
- The duration of internship may be curtailed or temporarily suspended or even withdrawn or cancelled at any time by the institution or University according to the prevailing rules or regulations of the relevant authority,

- (i) the registrant, due to any reason whatsoever, desires not to pursue CRMI; or
- (ii) the registrant is not found to have fulfilled eligibility requirements; or
- (iii) there are proven acts of indiscipline; or
- (iv) there are proven acts of professional misdemeanor or misconduct; or
- (v) any other acts or actions including those violating law of the land.
- (d). An intern shall be allowed to avail the following leaves;-
- A. Normal Leave
- (i) Interns shall be permitted a maximum of fifteen days leave with prior permission, during the entire period of internship.
- (ii) The entire period of fifteen days cannot be availed during any of the one week or two weeks postings applicable to a single department or specialty
  - B. Maternity Leave:
- (i) Lady Interns may be permitted Maternity Leave according to prevailing rules and regulations of the Central Government or State Government, as may be applicable
- C. Paternity Leave: Male interns may be permitted paternity leave for two weeks either in continuation or in intervals of one week each within one year of internship.
  - D. Medical Leave:
  - (i) Medical Leave shall be included within the fifteen days of normal leave.
  - (ii) Any medical leave beyond this period shall be recommended only by a duly constituted Medical Board.
  - E. The internship shall be extended if the leave of absence of any kind exceeds beyond this period:
  - (i) The period of extension shall be equivalent to the period beyond permissible fifteen days of leave.
- (ii) The internship shall be repeated only in the department or specialty wherein the above extension is

#### SCHEDULE- II

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR COMPLETION OF CRMI

The following requirements need to be fulfilled to be eligible for CRM!.

- 1. Indian Medical Graduates
- (a) The applicant should have successfully completed the MBBS course of any University from a college or institution approved and recognised by the Commission and listed by the Undergraduate Medical Education Board under the provisions of section 35 of the Act.
- (b) The qualifying examination for Indian Medical Graduates shall be in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations of the Commission at the time of commencement of internship;
  - (i) The Final MBBS Examination of various Universities or institutions of India;
- (ii) The National Exit Test (NExT) Step-1 held under sub-section (1) of section 15 of the Act whenever this examination becomes operational;
- (iii) Any other requirement as may be regulated or notified by the Central Government or, as the case may be, the Commission.
- (c) All Indian Medical Graduates shall complete their entire period of compulsory rotating internship training (CRMI) in the institution where they have pursued and completed their Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS);
- (i) One-year approved service in the Armed Forces Medical Services, after passing the final MBBS examination shall be considered as equivalent to the pre- registration training detailed above; and such training shall, as far as possible, be at the Base or General Hospital. The training in Community Medicine should fulfill the norms of the NMC as proposed above. However NExT step 2 will be mandatory for these candidates also.

#### 2. Foreign Medical Graduates

- (a) All Foreign Medical Graduates, as regulated by the National Medical Commission (Foreign Medical Graduate Licentiate) Regulations, 2021, are required to undergo internship at par with Indian Medical Graduates if they desire to seek Permanent Registration to practice Medicine in India.
- (i) All Foreign Medical Graduates, unless otherwise notified shall be required to undergo CRMI at par with Indian Medical Graduates after the National Exit Test Step-1 after NExT becomes operational.
- (b) Indian citizens (including overseas Indian citizens) who are Foreign Medical Graduates who do not fall under the purview of the National Medical Commission (Foreign Medical Graduate Licentiate) Regulations, 2021shall be regulated by the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 13 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956) in accordance with the Advisory no MCI-203(1)(Gen)/2020- Regn/118239, dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2020 and shall be required to complete CRMI in India if they have not undergone such practical training after obtaining such qualification as may be required by the rules and regulations in force in the country granting such qualification or has not undergone any practical training in that country.
- (c) Foreign Medical Graduates who require to complete a period of Internship shall do so only in medical colleges or institutions approved for providing CRMI to Indian Medical Graduates;
- (i) Foreign Medical Graduates may be posted first in colleges which have been newly opened and have yet to be recognized;
- (ii) May be posted to different medical colleges or institutions through a counseling or seat allocation process based on the merit:
- (iii) Medical colleges or institutions may allow up to 7.5 per cent of their permitted quota of interns to accommodate internship by Foreign Medical Graduates.
- (d) The college or institution and its affiliated hospitals and Community Health Centres shall be recognised by the Commission for conducting the CRMI programme

- 1. Notice of motion.
- 2. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the Respondents.
- 3. The Petitioners are aggrieved by two specific clauses of the notification dated 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2020, annexed as Annexure P-15 to the petition, issued by the Department of Medical Education & Research (Health-III Branch), Government of Punjab, as regards admission to the MBBS/BDS courses in medical and dental institutes in the State of Punjab from 2020 session onwards.
- 4.The first of these clauses is Clause 16, titled 'Admission to Private Institutes', which pertains to the distribution of seats in private medical/dental institutions. In particular, the grievance is against 16 (i), which stipulates that theseats in the aforesaid institutions be distributed asunder:-

"Government quota seats: 50%.

Management/Minority quota seats: 50% (including 15% NRI quota)"

5. Mr. Gurminder Singh, learned Senior Counsel for the Petitioners contends that in view of the settled legal position, as explained by the Supreme Court in *P.A. Inamdar v. State of Maharastra (2005) 6 SCC 537*, such appropriation of seats by the State in respect of unaided private educational institutions is impermissible.

For Subsequent orders see CM-274-CWP-2024, CM-7905-CWP-2024, -- and 1 more.

6. The second clause that the Petitioners are aggrieved by is Clause 14 (c), titled 'Fee for admission for M.B.B.S. course in Private Institutes/Universities'. The aforesaid seeks to regulate fees in MBBS courses in private institutions and universities, by stipulating as under:

2 <sup>nd</sup> year	Rs.3, 85,000/-	Rs.9, 90,000/-

4 <sup>th</sup> year	Rs.4, 55,000/-	Rs.11, 70,000/-
5th year	Rs.2, 45000/-	Rs.6, 30,000/-

- 7. Mr. Gurminder Singh, learned Senior Counsel points out that the fee fixed for the government quota seats is just 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of that chargeable for the management quota seats. He submits that if the appropriation of seats in terms of Clause 16 itself is impermissible, then such regulation of the fee structure for the government quota seats would also be illegal.
- 8. Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, appearing for the Respondents, points out that although there is a 50% government quota stipulated for the seats, there is no interference by the Government with admission to such seats, which is on the basis of the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test ('NEET'). According to him, the real controversy pertains to the fees for admission to the 50% government quota.
- 9. Since this is an issue that would have to be examined in some detail, while directing notice of motion to issue in the present petition, 4 weeks' time is granted to the Respondents to file their reply. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.
- 10. It is directed that in the meanwhile, the Petitioners will be permitted to collect the fee prescribed for the management quota even in respect of the 50% government quota seats, subject to the stipulation that the differential amount qua the government quota seats be kept, within two weeks of the completion of the admission process, in a Fixed Deposit by Petitioner No.2 in its own name,

with a copy of the Fixed Deposit Receipt being furnished to the Department of For Subsequent orders see CM-274-CWP-2024, CM-7905-CWP-2024, -- and 1 more.

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Medical Education & Research, State of Punjab, and with the further stipulation that the said FDR shall not be encashed by the Petitioners till further orders of this Court.

11. It is further directed that while granting admission to the students, the Petitioners will inform them that the reduction in the amount of fees prescribed for the previous academic year is the subject matter of challenge by the Petitioners in the present petition, and that the differential fees, if any, payable by the students would be subject to the outcome of the present petition.
