UGNEET-2025 - Stray Vacancy Round Seat Allotment to AYUSH courses¹

The Hon'ble Supreme Court has ordered the reallocation to the candidates admitted to SHME Trust Siddanta Ayurvedic Medical College and Research Institute, Vijayapura Road, Athani (College Code: I800) for the year 2025 to other colleges in SLP No. 29987/2025.

In this regard, the candidates admitted to the "College Code: I800 - Siddanta Ayurvedic Medical College and Research Institute, Vijayapura Road, Athani" for the year 2025 are hereby informed to compulsorily participate in the ongoing Stray Vacancy Round and enter their options.

Options can be entered - up to 11.00 am on 16-11-2025

Furthermore, the Principal of "Siddanta Ayurvedic Medical College and Research Institute, Vijayapura Road, Athani" College has to inform all the joined candidates to participate compulsorily in the Stray Vacancy Round without fail. UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. Issue notice, returnable in four weeks.
2. Dasti, in addition, is permitted.
3. By way of an ad interim order, we stay the impugned judgment and order passed by the learned Division Bench of the High Court.
4. We clarify that the students who are admitted in respondents (Colleges/Institutes) would be offered admission by the Counselling Authorities in any other recognized Colleges/Institutes.
5. Insofar as the direction to inspect the facilities of the respondents is concerned, the same shall not be affected by the stay granted by this Court.
6. However, we clarify that the petitioner shall conduct the inspection on any date, without intimating the respondents, within a period of four weeks from today.
