Important Instructions to Candidates on CAUTION DEPOSIT

for Medical Second Round seat allotment

- a. All category candidates who opted Choice-3 in the first round and candidates entered the options in the first round but not allotted any seat in first round and willing to participate in the second round for <u>UG Medical</u> seat should pay the Caution Deposit of Rs.1,00,000/- (One Lakhs only) to become eligible to participate in the second round.
- b. Caution deposit is not required for Dental / Ayurveda / Homoeopathy and Engineering / Agriculture / Veterinary / Nursing etc UGCET courses.
- c. Seat allotted in UGNEET first round Medical / Dental / AYUSH seat selected Choice-2 and paid the fees need not pay the Caution Deposit.
- d. If a candidate gets the medical seat, the caution deposit paid by the candidate will be adjusted towards the fee.
- e. If a candidate gets the medical seat in the second round and fails to pay the balance fees or fails to report to the college, caution deposit paid by the candidate will be forfeited and the candidate has to pay the complete first year fee to KEA as per rules.
- f. The fee paid at KEA for other courses, will not be considered as caution deposit.
- g. Schedule to pay the caution deposit will be notified later.

SECOND ROUND OPTION ENTRY

Candidates who have paid the caution deposit will only be allowed to re-order options based on the first round CHOICE selection for second round. If a candidate fails to pay the caution deposit to participate in the second round for UG medical seats, such candidates will not be considered for second round medical seat allotment even if they have entered the medical options in the first round.
